Sunday, March 10
Reflection of Redemption - Judas

1. What stood out most to you in this week's message?
2. Judas' betrayal of Jesus for thirty pieces of silver is a story many of us have heard before. What do you think motivated Judas to betray Jesus, especially considering his close relationship with him and witnessing his miracles?
3. Have you ever experienced a moment of deep remorse or conviction, similar to what Judas experienced? How did you respond to it, and what role did surrender play in your journey toward healing?
4. (John 6:26-27, Romans 11:35) Andrew and Rick talked about a "transactional heart" in the message this week, emphasizing the danger of viewing relationships with God and others as transactions. How do you see this transactional mindset lived out in your own life or in the church community?
5. (Matthew 16:24-26, Romans 12:1-2, Psalm 51:10) What practical steps can you take to create a heart of surrender in your daily life, particularly in the context of their relationships with God and others? What relationships do you need to work on specifically?
6. Close your time with your group sharing prayer needs that are weighing on you personally during this season of your life.

Do not feel 'bound' to this discussion guide or feel pressured to get through every question. If one question sparks meaningful and fruitful conversation, go with it!
